


Wiring up a Swiss Plug.

- 1. Unscrew the outer case and remove, unscrew cable clamp and unscrew required terminal.
- 2. Place the Strain relief on the cable.
- 3. Strip the cable according to Figure 1.
- 4. Connect the cable to the correct terminals and fasten screws to hold in place.
- 5. Place the Strain Relief inside the body.
- 6. Screw Cable clamp over the cable making sure its clamped over the _{Neutral (Blue)} cable outer.
- 7. Replace the Lid and fasten screw till tight.
